Abraham Lincoln	red	6-10 oz.	I	77	Popular since the 1920's. Fruit has a perfect balance of sugar & acid.
Ananas Noire	purple/green/black	16-24 oz.	I	80	Multi-colored inside & out, these have a sweet flavor that is also rich & delicious.
Aussie	red	1-2 lbs.	I	85	Aussie heirloom with flavor as big as the fruit-bursting with a great blend of sugars & acids.
Belgian Giant	dark pink	1-2 lbs.	I	90	Delicious flavor, meaty with few seeds. Great for cooking & canning.
Big Zebra	green/red striped	12-16 oz.	I	85	Unusual striking appearance with a mild sweet flavor.
Black Cherry	dark mahogany	1-2"	I	65	The first black, perfectly round cherry with all the rich & complex flavor of black tomatoes.
Black from Tula	reddish brown	8-12 oz.	I	77	Russian heirloom that is very productive & has a rich, sweet flavor.
Black Krim	dark brown-red	10-12 oz.	I	85	Russian heirloom from Black Sea region. Flavor is rich & sweet with a hint of saltiness.
Black Zebra	deep burgundy	3-4 oz.	I	75	Sporting jagged green stripes on mahogany flesh, solid mahogany inside. Great flavor.
Brandywine OTV	bright red	12-16 oz.	I	72	With their creamy texture & sweet flavor, you'll enjoy them off the vine all season long.
Carbon	purplish brick red	8-12 oz.	I	80	One of the best tasting tomatoes, with flattened-round smooth fruits.
Cherokee Chocolate	chocolate/mahogany	12-16 oz.	I	80	Popular with celebrity chefs because its exceptionally rich & complex tomato flavor.
Cherokee Purple	purple	10-12 oz.	I	85	Color carries through to flesh, especially at stem. Resistant to septora leaf spot.
Copia Striped	gold & red striped	12-16 oz.	I	85	Very juicy, flavorful & sweet. Named for the Center for Food, Wine & Art in Napa, CA.
Dr. Wyche's Yellow	golden yellow	12-16 oz.	I	85	One of the best tasting yellow tomatoes-meaty beefsteak type.
Galina's	golden yellow	1"	I	75	This Siberian heirloom produces long, fruit-laden clusters of rich, sweet & complex fruit.
Great White	creamy white	1-2 lbs.	I	85	Large beefsteak with sweet flavor, lots of juice. Dense foliage protects from sun scald.
Green Zebra	green	1-2 1/2"	I	80	Fruits with various shades of yellow to yellowish-green stripes, sweet zingy flavor.
Mr. Stripey	yellow/pink stripes	1-3 lbs.	I	80	Mild, low acid flavor & intriguing color. Mennonite heirloom from the 1800's.
Mortgage Lifter	pink	1-2 lbs.	I	90	Kentucky heirloom. Meaty beefsteak, typically crack free. Great old fashioned tomato flavor.
Mule Team	red	8-12 oz.	I	86	Sweet fruit with slight tang. Workhorse tomato, produces long into season.
Neve's Azorean Red	deep red	1-3 lbs.	I	75	Huge beautiful beefsteaks bursting with magnificent flavor. The ultimate sandwich tomato.
Old German	yellow	1-2 lbs.	I	85	Mennonite heirloom. Golden yellow with red & pink stripes. Rich and full of flavor.
Orange Oxheart	orange	1 lb.	I	80	Heart shaped fruit. Meaty with firm, solid flesh, a rich aroma and superior flavor.
Persimmon Orange	golden orange	16-20 oz.	I	80	One of the best flavored orange tomatoes, this has a meaty texture with few seeds.
Prince Borghese	red	1 1/2"	D	75	This is the Italian favorite for drying. Plum shaped fruits have little juice and few seeds.
San Marzano	bright red	8 oz.	I	80	Tuscan heirloom is a huge plum tomato used for cooking, but flavorful enough to eat fresh.
Stupice	red	2 oz.	I	52	Czech heirloom that bears an abundance of flavorful & sweet jewels.
Valencia	orange	8-10 oz.	I	76	Hard to find, threatened variety with a rich buttery flavor and few seeds.
Wild Cherry	bright red	1/2"	I	60	These tiny tomatoes are packed with rich flavor and perfectly balanced with sweetness.
Zapotec Pink Ribbed	dark Pink	10 oz.	I	80	Heavily ribbed Mexican heirloom from Zapotec region. Prolific yields of mild, sweet fruit.

Dixie Golden Giant	lemon yellow	1-2 lbs.	I	85	Fabulous sweet fruit taste in a huge, clear lemon-yellow beefsteak. Large plants & harvest.
Early Wonder	dark pink	6 oz.	D	55	The real wonder is how so much flavor is packed into these extra early gems.
Fireworks	bright red	6-8 oz.	I	60	This exceptional variety is one of the earliest red slicing tomatoes with excellent flavor.
Grape	red	¾"	I	55	Long, grape-like clusters of sweet, delicious fruit.
Hawaiian Pineapple	orange	1-1 ½ lbs.	I	93	Golden orange beefsteak. Rich, sweet, pineapple melon-like flavor with heady fragrance.
Hawaiian Tropic	red	16-20 oz.	I	65	Proven performer in the heat of Las Vegas. Meaty & tasty fruit even at 110 degrees!
Heatwave II	red	6-7 oz.	D	68	Extremely disease resistant. Performs exceptionally well in desert heat.
Japanese Oxbart	pink	8-12 oz.	I	90	Expect extra high yields and a richer flavor than you will find with most other oxbarts.
Legend	glossy red	8 oz.	D	68	Earliness, great taste and disease resistance make this truly memorable.
Lemon Boy	yellow	8-10 oz.	I	72	The 1 <sup>st</sup> lemon yellow & still one of the best. Outstanding mild & sweet yet tangy flavor.
Marglobe	red	6 oz.	D	75	Released in 1925. One of the first wilt resistant tomatoes. Great for canning.
Momotaro	pink	8-10 oz.	I	74	The most popular tomato in Japan, the taste is intensely rich & sweet. You'll love it!
Red Pear	red	1 ½ -2"	I	78	Miniature pear shaped fruits are great for salads.
Siletz	deep red	8-10 oz.	D	52	Full flavored slicing tomato performs well even in cool weather.
Sugary	reddish-pink	1"	I	60	2005 All-America Selections Award Winner. Very sweet cherry tomato, high yield vines.
Sweet Million	dark red	1"	I	65	Same wonderful flavor as Sweet 100, but with better disease & crack resistance.
Yellow Pear	yellow	1 ½ -2"	I	78	Combine these with the red pear to make a beautiful garnish or salad topper.
